## Proposal for Amendment of the Club Constitution

## 22 February 2023

The following proposal is delivered to the Club Secretary under the requirements of Clause 11 of the Strathearn Harriers' Club Constitution "Alteration of the Constitution". It is suggested that the required 'forum meeting' takes place at the AGM, and the vote required by Clause 11(b) takes place at that AGM. These amendments are for the purpose of:
a) Providing for the filling of any committee vacancies that arise between Annual General Meetings. (Changes to Clauses 6 and 7)
b) Clarifying the requirement for an AGM and the status of Club Committee members at it. (Changes to Clause 9)
c) Ensuring that future club general meetings can take place online, if either required or preferred. (Changes to Clauses 9, 11 and 12)

It is proposed that the current Club Constitution (adopted 8 March 2019) is amended as follows (changes highlighted for clarity):
